STOP: 2124 Louisiana Ave. (Black Elegant Women Social & Pleasure Club) Down Louisiana to LaSalle, turn right on LaSalle, go to Jackson Ave. STOP: Chicken Mart (Single Ladies Social & Pleasure Club) Left on Jackson to 2731 Jackson Ave. STOP: (Kree, Toast to the Queen) Down Jackson to Claiborne, turn left on Claiborne to Washington Ave. Turn left on Washington to LaSalle, right on LaSalle, U-turn to Dew Drop Inn. DISBAND: Dew Drop Inn (2836 LaSalle St, New Orleans, LA 70115).
